

WAGE SLIP.

Gross wages to date: How much money you've received in this tax year.

Name: This is the person who the payslip is issued to.

Date: The date of the payslip. If weekly this will be the end date. If monthly the month & year will be shown.

Code Number: Your tax code, used to calculate you tax free personal income.

Tax week/month Number: How many weeks/months into the current year.

Tax Deducted to Date: How much money has been deducted to this date.

Company Pension: Optional amount deducted if you are part of a company pensions scheme.

Income Tax: How much Income Tax you've paid.

National Insurance: How much National Insurance you've paid (on this wage slip)

Other Deductions: Optional, if any deductions not listed above.

Deductions: The total amount the employer has deducted from your gross wages.

Tax Credits: Any tax credit benefits that you are eligible for.

Net Pay: The actual amount you will find in your wage packet.

Sick Pay: Any statutory sick pay or statutory maternity pay you have received.
